PROGRAM: Peer-learning activity at Charles University
„Grey zones in WWII history – good practice sharing“

The activity focuses on sharing good practice between the Czech and Norwegian teams in teaching and researching lesser-known contexts, events and phenomena related to the Second World War. The activity will focus on sharing concrete examples from Czech, Norwegian and world war history. The national narrative and the perception of the Second World War in contemporary society will also be reflected. A central theme of the activity will be the search for how to incorporate these grey areas into existing teaching and research in university courses on a broader scale. The activity is key to the implementation of outcomes IO1 and IO3. The activity will also include visits to research and archival institutions and networking between Czech and Norwegian historians.
